

DO'S AND DON'TS OF LADDER SAFETY




DON'T...



Don't stand on the top rung! Don't work higher than the third rung.




Don't use the ladder if it isn't fully extended.




OR MOVE THE LADDER IF SOMEONE IS ON IT!



Don't place your ladder on uneven ground.




Don't climb a ladder holding tools in your hands.

Don't place the ladder where you could get knocked off.









Do have a secure place to hold, no higher than 3rd rung from the top.



Do wear proper footwear (non-slip flat shoes).



Do prevent passers-by from walking under or near the ladder.



Do maintain 3 points of contact.
